



8. MEMBER OF THE TRUST

The settler and the life time trustees may constitute with their mutual consent the board of the trust to manage the day to day affairs under the kind control of the founder.

However, later on, one elected member from the life-time Trustees and two elected from the ordinary Trustees and one from the associates shall be added on to the Board. Without the presence of at least two life-times Board members the meeting of the Board shall not be valid. The quorum of the Board will be four, but at least two of the life-time Board members should be present. The members of the Board shall not be more than nine or less than two. If it is nine, one from the life-time Trustees additionally shall be added on.



CHAIRMAN AND SECRETARY-

Chairman is permanent for life-time as he is he Founder of the Trust for the propagation of his ideals and techniques based on ancient esoteric spiritual wisdom of India, for the welfare of the human beings irrespective of caste, creed and colour.

- There must be another Trustee appointed as the Secretary-cum-Executive Trustee of the Trust. The administration and executive functioning of the Trust must be vested on him for his life-time. He has to deal with the material welfare of the members and well-wishers of the Board in consultation with the Chairman. If any new Trustee has to be enlisted inthe Board of Trustees, the Board has to get prior sanction of the Chairman of the Board of Trustees. Expert Trustees can be nomination by the unanimous decision of the Board of Trustees from among the distinguished social workers with spiritual inclination, with prior consent of the Chairman of the Board of Trustees. These Trustees shall have the right to be Trustees for five years. They can continue with the unanimous permission of the Trust Board in the next continuing terms.
- The period of ordinary and Associate Trustees shall be five years. They can continue as Trustees with the unanimous consent of the Trust Board, with the prior consent of the Chairman of the Board of Trustees.


108 The funds of the Trust shall be invested in the modes pecified under the provisions of section 13 (1) (d) read with Section 11 (3) of the Income-tax Act, 1961, as pamended from time to time. The investments and more specifically the Bank account of the Trust shall be operated by the Chairman of Secretary jointly with any other Board member.

- 11. The Trust moneys shall not be invested with any private individuals or firm or association of persons or body of individuals.
- 12. The secretary/GOB shall maintain all account of the Trust regularly. The accounts shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant, every year. Accounts will be closed on 31st March, each year.
- 13. No amendments to this Trust Deed and Bye-laws shall be made which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of Sections 2 (15), 11, 12, 13 and 80-G of the Income-tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time. Further no amendment shall be carried out without the prior approval of the Commissioner of Income-tax.
- 14. In case of death, inability, resignation or refusal on the part of any Trustees to Act, as such Trustee the remaining Trustees shall be entitled to nominate any other person as they

may think fit and proper to act as Trustee in place of the Trustee so dying, refusing to act or being unable to act:

Provided that the Trustee so appointed will have the same onus and right as if he was originally appointed the Trustee under these presents.

- 15. The Board of Trustees may remove from office any Trustee except the Chairman and Secretary if in their opinion such Trustee has ceased to represent the interest which he purports to represent on the Board, provided that reasonable opportunity is given to such Trustee to make any representation against the proposed action.
- 16. In the event of dissolution or winding up of the Trust the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed amount the Trustees, but the same shall be transferred to another charitable Trust/society whose object are similar to those of this Trust and which enjoys recognition under Section 80-G of the Income-tax Act, 1961, as amended from time to time.
- 17. The Trustees can received gifts/donations either from any one of them or from others in cash or in kind and the gift so received together with the initial sum of Rs 5000.00 (Rupees Five thousand one only) from founder settled under this Deed shall form the corpus of the Trust.
 - 18. The funds and properties of the Trust shall consist of:
 - ✓ The sum of Rs 5000100 (FivelyThousand One Only) which has been settled by the settler.
 - ✓ ✓ Gifts/donations either in cash or in kind which may be made by any
 - donations made for any such specified purpose or objects.
 - Properties movable and immovable which may be acquired by the Trust by purchase, exchange, lease, gift or otherwise.
 - ✓ Income and profits from the properties of the Trust.
 - Any fees, charges, etc, as may be collected, in the course of any public or private performance by artistes, etc.
- 19. The objects of the Trust: The main object of the trust so greated is exclusively for the welfare and educational aid of general mass like S.C. STC, Minority and others weaker section of the society are as below:-
 - √ To provide fees, books, equipments, free ships, and/or scholarships to deserving students.
 - To feed poor students and to start free student homes and free hostels.
 - ✓ To help and assist poor and deserving people in marriage.



- To conduct seminars/workshops and arrange special tuition/training for
- To provide/assist in setting up village industries and other S.S.I
- ✓ To make donations to other public charitable Trusts/institutions recognized under Section 80-G of the Income-Tax Act, 1961.
- ✓ To set up and operate schools residential or day school, colleges. ,language college ,training centre, Technical training Centre, Industrial Training Institute (I.T.I.), Engineering college, polytechnic college ,medical college and all other educational faculty necessary for the upliftment of the life style of the society and to make the society well educated.
- ✓ To conduct nutritional and health services and to establish Hospital &. Medical college to provide medical aid and education to the poorer and weaker section of the society.
- ✓ To conduct/operate programmers fro providing nutritional assistance e.g. to operate a school/lunch/food programmed for children, operate nutritional supplement programmed for needy women which shall be provided/conducted/distributed free of charge.
- Testing of diets from nutritional view point.
- ✓ To render assistance to poor patients by providing medicines etc., provisions of health care, preventive medical services (including dental services)
- ✓ Assistance to hospitals in setting up the various facilities such as Blood Bank, Eye Bank, Burn Centers, etc. for the poor patients.
- ✓ Provision of outdoor dispensary or assistance thereof and also to run "Mobile" medical service.
- ✓ Conduct education in health care or provide assistance in the provision of primary health care education.
- To set up hospitals/nursing homes for children/women.
- To render assistance to the handicapped.
- ✓ To provide monetary assistance and social services in case of natural calamities.
- To render financial assistance to the poor and the disadvantaged.
- To promote advancement welfare of the people.
- ✓ To set up Vocational Training for women/widow /Divorce women etc. To promote social arts, culture, sports and others activities.
- To make awareness in the society about aids, polio, illiteracy, poverty, and others necessary activities from time to time.
- And all other activity (Education & Health) for the welfare of the society from time to time with the consent of the majority of the vote of the life time trustee.
- 20 . The Trustees shall have all powers as may be required for the proper conduct of the affairs of the Trust. The Trustees shall have the power to initiate prosecutions and defend legal proceedings as may be reasonable and proper for safeguarding the assets and properties of the Irust as also the Trust Funds and interest. Any action taken by such Trustees in this regard shall be cleemed to have been taken and ratified by all Trustees.
 - 21. The Trustees may open an account or accounts with any Bank or Banks in the name of the Trust to be operated upon by any one Trustee jointly and founder of the trust or severally or the authorized representative of the Trust on behalf of the Trust.

The surplus funds of the Trust which has not been spent in any year shall be invested in the modes prescribed under relevant sections of the Income-tax Act, 1961, as amended from time to time.

23. The Trustees shall at their discretion, acquire, purchase or sell immovable properties or movable properties in the course of managing of Trust. However,

any sale of immovable shall require prior consent of at least 3/4th majority of the Trustees.

- 24. No income of the Trust shall be applied for the personal benefit either of the Trustees or of the Settler except the genuine day to day expenses necessary to discharge the duty and obligation towards the achievement of the object of the trust, that expenses will be reimbursed to the person /trustee concerned.
- 25. In the event of dissolution or winding up of the Trust, the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed among the Trustees/Members of the Managing Committee/ Members of the Governing Body, but the same shall be transferred to another Charitable Trust, Society, Association or Institution whose objects are similar to those of this Trust and which enjoys recognition under relevant section of the Income-tax Act, 1961.
- 26. No amendment to the terms of this Deed shall be made without obtaining the prior written permission of the Commissioner of Income-tax. However, the amendments of be carried out shall not infringe the provisions of the Income-tax Act, 1961.
- 27 The objects of the Trust shall be achieved without involving any activity for profit.
- 28. The Trustees and the members of their family shall not be entitled to the benefits

of the Trust.

- 29. The Trust formed is irrevocable.
- 30. The funds/income of the Trust shall be solely utilized for achieving the objects of the Trust and no portion of it shall be utilized for the benefit of the Trustees by way of interest, bonus, dividend, profit, etc.
- 31. The benefits of the Trust shall be open to weaker section, BPL family and the community living below the poverty line within as well as general people without distinguishing their cast, religion and others within Indian Territory.
- 32. The accounts of the Trust shall be regularly maintained and the by a Chartered Accountant every year. The accounting year to the Trust Stail be from 1st April to 31st March each year and the founder along with a life and member shall operate the bank account jointly. However, are the convenience of the trust the chairman (founder) may admit or permit with the consent of the members of board, to any members for the bank operation if so necessary. But in all case the bank account shall be jointly operated.
